

The regular meeting of the Kinderhook Township Board was called to order by Paul Meredith on Tuesday, May 29, 2007 at 7:30 p.m. at the Kinderhook Township hall. The pledge, led by Gary Stetler, was recited to the American flag. All members were present.

**Citizen Comments:**

Floor was opened at 7:34. There were no citizen's comments.

**Commissioner's Report:** Norm Heinemann gave a brief report.

**Sheriff's Report:** 12,000 complaints were filed last year. The secondary road patrol will move from 6 a.m. – 6 p.m. to later hours beginning June 10<sup>th</sup>.

**Treasurer's Report:**

Castor reported May's expenses of \$10,807.49, revenues of \$27,834.88 with cash on hand of \$331,381.15. Barnes moved to accept the Treasurer's report and pay the bills. Stetler seconded. Motion carried.

**Zoning Report:**

Six permits were issued and four zoning complaints. Mr. Davis lost his appeal and the sign needs to come down.

**Old Business:**

Shemel 's Carpet & Interiors submitted a bid of \$540.00 to repair the hallway flooring and \$210.00 for 4'x10' waterhog mat. Newby moved and Barnes seconded the motion to accept the bid to have Shemel's repair the hallway and to buy the waterhog mat. Motion carried.

**New Business:**

Stetler moved and Newby seconded a motion to approve paying the MTA dues for 2007-2008 in the amount of \$1,476.33. Motion carried.

The 2007 Tax Rate Request for Millage was signed by Newby and Meredith.

Newby moved and Castor seconded a motion to sign an agreement between Kinderhook Township and the Branch County Treasurer to collect delinquent personal property taxes. Motion carried.

A conference table has been offered to the township for free. Barnes will pick up the table.

Barnes moved to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Stetler. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:20 p.m.
